

How to Search and Request (enroll in) an NM COVID Online Curriculum

1. From the **NM Learning & Performance** home page, click on the **Search** icon.



- 2. Search for the curriculum by entering **NM COVID**.
- 3. Click on the title of the appropriate curriculum. The possible choices are the following:
 - NM COVID Nurse Resource Pool Education: ICU
 Description: This education is intended for nurses who have ICU experience but have not worked in an ICU area recently. The curricula will provide the knowledge they will need to staff in an ICU area.
 - NM COVID Nurse Resource Pool Education: Med/Surg
 Description: This education is intended for nurses who are very novice or have been doing non-hospital based care. The curricula will provide knowledge to staff a Med/Surg COVID-19 floor.
 - NM COVID Respiratory Therapy Care
 Description: This education is intended for nurses and other caregivers who need knowledge on respiratory therapy care practices and procedures.
 - NM COVID Donning and Doffing Reusable Surgical Masks and N95 Respirators
 Description: This education provides instructions on how to don a used N95 mask, and how to wear, discard and store a surgical mask.
- 4. Click on the Request button.
- Click on the Open
 Curriculum button to view all of the curriculum's components.
 Click on the component you want to open.
