

New Look for Care Everywhere Outside Records Activity


- The Care Everywhere Outside Records Activity has been updated for easier access to relevant patient information and to be more consistent with Chart Review.

 - Documents: Updated to be more like the Encounters tab in Chart Review. Summary tab has been retired because summary documents appear on the Documents tab.





Documents have a Fresh Look and New Workflow

- Care Everywhere has been updated to align more closely with Chart Review. Most action buttons now appear in the report toolbar. You can use the wrench icon to modify the report layout.
 - The Update button was previously called Request Document Update.
 - The Additional Documents section is now below the header of the document.
 - Banners are used to indicate actions users need to take, such as when a patient authorization is required to request updates.





Mark Outside Information as Reviewed

- Able to mark outside information as reviewed in the Reconcile Outside information activity. All information in a tab does not need to be added or discarded for the tab to be marked as reviewed.
- A new checkbox is selected by default marking outside information on the tab as reviewed when Accept or Accept/Next is selected.
- A check mark appears on the folder icon for the tab once the information has been reviewed.



New MyChart Patient Message Center (1 of 2) MyChart (Patient-Facing)

- Navigating past messages or sending new ones is more intuitive in the updated MyChart Message Center in the mobile app.
- Messages for patients are now grouped into folders for easier access
 - Conversations: main message folder
 - Bookmarked: messages bookmarked by patient to revisit later
 - Appointment: appointment related messages (scheduling requests, cancellations)
 - Automated messages: automated messages such as payment confirmation or questionnaire submission confirmations
 - Trash: patient deleted messages that can be restored to the main conversation list if desired





New MyChart Patient Message Center (2 of 2)

MyChart (Patient-Facing)

- Navigating past messages or sending new ones is more intuitive in the updated MyChart Message Center.
- Changes for patients:
 - View conversation threads in sequential order
 - Bookmark conversations for easy access in the future
 - Search for messages by keyword
 - Quickly identify questionnaires or scheduling tasks they need to complete
- Changes for providers:
 - Can no longer change the message subject. This ensures messages are kept in the same conversation thread.
 - If a patient sends multiple messages before the provider has had a chance to view them, all of the messages are merged into a single message in the In Basket folder to reduce clutter.



FRAIL Questionnaire Now Available in MyChart



E-Prescribing





COVID-19 Pfizer and Moderna Series Updated for Third Doses (1 of 2)

Immunizations

- On August 13, 2021, the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) updated its recommendations to require a third dose in the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccination series for certain moderately to severely immunocompromised patients.
- Moderna: If patients are 18 years or older, immunocompromised patients are now forecasted to receive a third dose of the Moderna vaccine if they have had fewer than three.
- **Pfizer:** If patients are 12 years or older, immunocompromised patients are now forecasted to receive a third dose of the Pfizer vaccine if they have had fewer than three.



COVID-19 Pfizer and Moderna Series Updated for Third Doses (2 of 2)

Immunizations

- Clinicians will no longer see a warning for these patients; the series is already complete when documenting a third Pfizer or Moderna dose in the Immunization activity.
- Patients are forecasted to receive the third dose of the vaccine if they have the Health Maintenance modifier indicating they should be evaluated for the COVID-19 risk series or have any of the following conditions:
 - HIV/AIDS
 - Phagocytic function defect, such as myeloperoxidase deficiency
 - Receiving CAR-T cell therapy
 - Receiving a hematopoietic stem cell transplant
 - Receiving an organ transplant
 - Severe B-lymphocyte antibody deficiencies, such as common variable deficiency
 - Receiving active treatment for solid tumors or hematologic malignancies
 - Receiving immunosuppressant therapy
 - Receiving radiation therapy



Janssen COVID-19 Vaccines are now Forecast in Health Maintenance

Immunizations

• When patients receive a single dose of the Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) COVID-19 vaccine, they now complete the COVID-19 Health Maintenance topic, as recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).



AstraZeneca & Novavax COVID-19 Vaccines are now Forecast in Health Maintenance

Immunizations

- Patients who receive a dose of the AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine are now forecast to receive a second dose 28 days later.
- Patients who receive a dose of Novavax COVID-19 vaccine are now forecast to receive a second dose 21 days later.
- If a patient receives two doses of either vaccine, the series is complete.

Unsecuring Hyperspace Opens the Workspace That Was Secured

Secure Button

- Epic has fixed an issue where unsecuring a session sometimes opened a different patient chart than the one the session was secured on.
- For example, a provider opens Mary's chart and places a medication order for her, but doesn't sign or pend the order. The provider then opens Tom's chart and secures the session, intending for the next provider to use Tom's chart as well. However, when the next provider unsecures Hyperspace, it brings up Mary's chart instead because Mary's order was automatically pended.
- The issue has been fixed so that Hyperspace always opens up the workspace that it was secured on. Following the above example, Tom's chart will open as expected.



Search on Sorted Columns on the Schedule

 - Previously, this kind of searching was possible only from the condensed rows view.




