

# Ambulatory Emergency Response PPE Kit

## Overview

Clinical staff supporting the care of an **unresponsive patient requiring CPR and/or bag-valve-mask support** (i.e. aerosol generating procedure) are to follow the recommendations as indicated in this document.

- All ambulatory care practices should create their own **Emergency Response PPE kits** to include the items listed below
- Establish an appropriate quota for your area. Recommendation is to have at least 4 kits per practice
- If your clinic has a bag-valve-mask (BVM), ensure it has a bacterial/viral filter attached

## Use of Emergency Response PPE Kit

If a patient becomes unresponsive while in the outpatient setting:

- Obtain COVID Emergency PPE Kit along with other emergency supplies
- Don: N95, gown, eye protection, and gloves **prior to** initiating CPR/bag-valve-mask support
- Keep the PPE on until all direct patient care is completed and/or the patient leaves the area/practice

## Post Response Cleaning:

- **If** CPR and/or bag-valve-mask support occurred **in the exam room**:
  - Once CPR and/or bag-valve-mask support is completed and the patient is removed from the area, staff can clean the area
  - Refer to the Ambulatory Reactivation Playbook under (insert section & link) and follow standard cleaning after aerosolized generating procedure in ambulatory setting.
- **If** CPR or bag-valve-mask support occurred **in public space** (hallway/waiting area):
  - **Clean the immediate area to include 6 feet around the patient, with a hospital-grade disinfectant**
- Replace equipment and replenish PPE supplies after the emergency response is completed.
