2W nursing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manage/monitor 3:1 for any COVID-19-positive patient (ratio may vary based on acuity of patient). • Manage/monitor 1:1 for any PUI patient. • Nurses-only care delivery model. • Nurses will conduct daily cleaning of high-touch points and will bag patient room trash receptacles and soiled linens. Double bag clear/clean liners for trash, and blue liners for linen. • Call EVS when trash is 75% full to facilitate hand-off. 	Daniel Webel
Physicians	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designated attending physician allowed in room. • Consults should be done via telehealth. 	Dr. Meesala
Respiratory	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilitate nebulizer to MDI transition. • Manage/monitor respiratory equipment (ambu bags, bipap, cpap). 	Shellie (Meshal) Idstein
Support Services (inc. Care Coordination, Interpreter Services, Spiritual Care, Pharmacy, Psychology, Laboratory, Dietary)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consider using telehealth where possible. • Video interpreter used for interpretation needs. • Nursing lab specimens. • Family Training will be converted to telehealth whenever possible. PT/OT/SLP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PT/OT/ST will connect with primary RN on therapy status. • Telehealth should be considered when appropriate for therapy. • If possible, see patients with COVID-19 positive or PUI after seeing other patients on your caseload. • If possible, observe patient with nursing or observe patient in room prior to entering room. You can gather information such as mobility/general abilities, ability to interact, and overall alertness. 	Kris Germain
Facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain/monitor bed inventory. • Create doffing area in front of room when no ante room. 	Mike Ambroz
EVS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • RN will complete cleaning once per shift. • Trash will be placed in clear bag. RN to call EVS when 75% full. • EVS will complete discharge clean. • Curtains will be changed with PUI or terminal clean. 	Christine Tantillo
Supply Chain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain/monitor PPE: N95 masks, procedure masks, eye shields (goggles as an alternative), gowns, PAPR hoods. • Maintain/monitor disposable equipment (i.e. thermometer, blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, disposable pulse oximeter probe). • Maintain/monitor available and approved cleaning agents. Infection Prevention	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain/monitor infection prevention operations. 	Heather Voss
IT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor/facilitate the need for additional equipment (i.e. iPads, stands). 	Kelli Landman
Food and Nutrition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • RN orders safety tray (disposable tray). • Tray is delivered to RN station and RN delivers tray to room. • Left-over items thrown away in patient's trash receptacle. 	Charles Davis
Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain No Visitor Policy (exception for family training conference when necessary). 	Daniel Webel
Corporate Health	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain/manage employee exposure. 	
Pharmacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain/manage nebulizer to MDI process. 	Caitlin Jones
Nursing Professional Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide ongoing staff education for donning and doffing. 	Daniel Webel
