

Covid-19 Positive Result 20 Day Review BPA

The COVID-19 Positive flag will update to COVID-19 Resolved at 20 days unless the patient is immunocompromised. If immunocompromised, please follow the workflow below. To clinically clear a patient before 20 days, please place a Clinical Clearance Order.

Rationale

- Allow the ability to reapply Covid-19 precautions if infection is still suspected
- Ensure tests are ordered appropriately for immunocompromised population

Choose next steps based on criteria

1. Patient meets criteria for continued Covid-19 symptoms.
2. Patient meets immunocompromised criteria for retesting.
3. If a decision cannot be made, select a defer reason.

- Organ or stem cell transplant, active chemotherapy for cancer, untreated HIV infection with CD4 T Lymphocyte count <200, combined primary immunodeficiency disorder, or receipt of prednisone >20mg/day for more than 14 days.
