Review the Updates


- For admitted patients whose COVID-19 infection flag expires while admitted, physicians will be prompted with a 20-day result review alert. Once the physician addresses the alert, the Positive Infection flag will update.
- For any Immunocompromised patients (including readmissions) whose COVID-19 infection flag expires, physicians will be prompted with a 20-day result review alert. Once the physician addresses the alert, the Positive Infection flag will update.

Rationale

- Implement a clinical review of the patient's COVID-19 infection and isolation status.
- Allow the ability to either reapply COVID-19 precautions or clinically clear the patient.
- Ensure tests are ordered appropriately for clinically clearing high risk patient populations.

Choose next steps based on criteria

When receiving the Best Practice Advisory, select one of the following:



- Patient Meets Criteria for Clinical Clearance:** select the Acknowledge Reason and contact nursing to change isolation status as clinically appropriate.
- Patient Meets High Risk/Immunocompromised Criteria:** Order retesting.
- Patient Meets Criteria for Continued COVID-19 Precautions:** Order Re-Apply COVID-19 Infection Status.
- If a decision cannot be made, select a defer option.

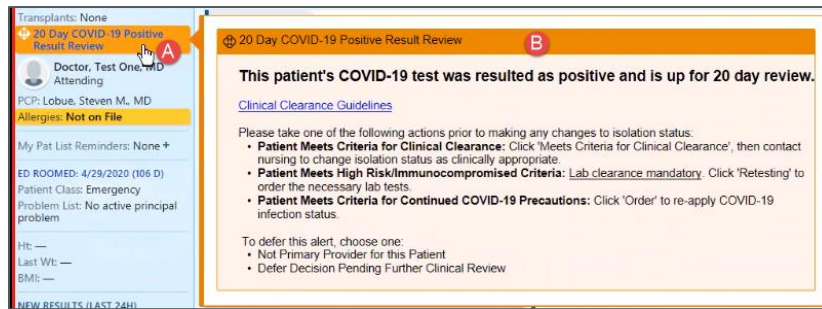
20 Day COVID-19 Positive Result Review BPA
