

# Completing the Flu Vaccination Consent Form

Individuals should complete their Flu Vaccination Consent Form before receiving their vaccine. The form can be accessed electronically two ways:

1. Visiting the Seasonal Influenza (Flu) Webpage **NMI>MyNM Service Center>Health & Safety>Seasonal Influenza (Flu) Program**. Click on the green *Flu Consent Form* button.

Flu Station Reminders:

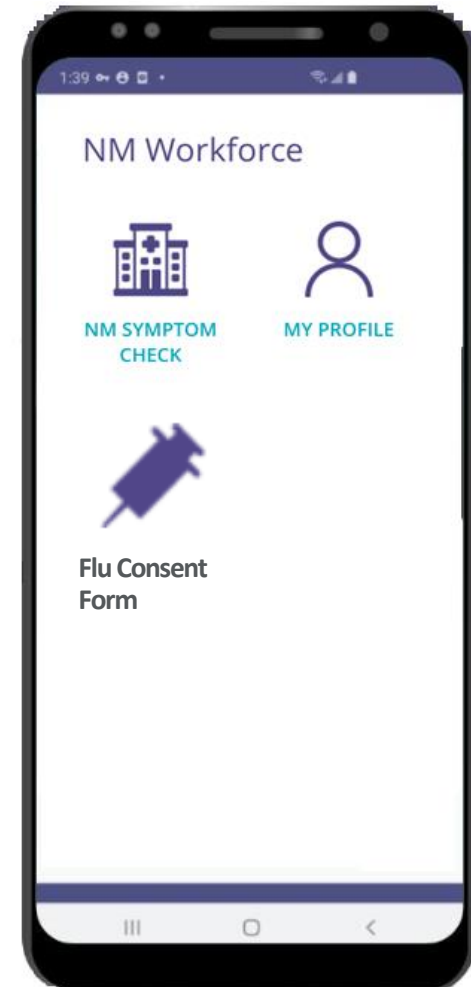
- Please complete your Flu Consent Form prior to arrival. Due to social distancing restrictions, we will no longer be offering the opportunity to complete a consent form at the flu stations.
  - You can complete your consent form two ways:
- Wear appropriate clothing for vaccine administration. The clinician will need to administer the vaccine three fingerbreadths below the top of your shoulder. Privacy screens will NOT be available at the flu stations. You may be redirected to NM Occupational health if your clothing is too restrictive.

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2. Clicking on the Flu Consent Form within the **NM Workforce Application**. *Please note, this feature will be available in early October.*

Please download the symptom tracker app and complete your attestation each day. Individuals should not come to work with symptoms of illness.
