FLU STATION REMINDERS

- ✓ To expedite the process, complete the electronic Consent Form prior to arrival:
 - 1. Login to MyNM Service Center
 - 2. Click the 'Health & Safety' icon
 - 3. Click on the 'Seasonal Influenza (Flu) Program' icon
 - 4. Click the green 'Flu Consent Form' button
- ✓ You will be required to show your Northwestern Medicine ID Badge in order to receive the flu vaccine.
- ✓ Flu stations will be stocked with regular quadrivalent preservative free flu vaccine. If you need a special vaccine (i.e. Egg Free) you will be redirected to NM Occupational Health.
- ✓ Wear appropriate clothing for vaccine administration. The clinician will need to administer the vaccine three fingerbreadths below the top of your shoulder. Privacy screens will **NOT** be available at the flu stations so you may be redirected to NM Occupational health if your clothing is too restrictive.
- √ The Flu Station Schedule is subject to change, check back on NMI for the most up to date schedule.
