


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# Influenza Vaccination


## **Admission Navigator**

The Influenza Screening will display below the Immunization history in the Admission Navigator, allowing the immunization history to be reviewed prior to screening the patient.



#### When screening for influenza:

- If the patient has received the influenza vaccination already, select **Yes**. Nothing more needs to be completed.
  - o Document the vaccine the patient received elsewhere in the Immunization History
- If the patient has not yet received the influenza vaccine this season and wants the vaccine, select: No/Patient Unsure. Continue to complete the allergies, contraindications and sensitivities.

### **Required Documentation**




If the patient is not screened at time of admission, Influenza screening will remain incomplete in the required admission documentation.


#### **Best Practice Advisories**

BPAs will fire based on age criteria offering the appropriate vaccine for that age and hospital location. Once the Nurse selects **None, order vaccine** and saves/files the documentation the appropriate BPA is triggered.

• Order is defaulted; click Accept to place the order.



If the flu vaccine has been ordered but is not yet administered, a BPA will fire once daily as a reminder that the vaccine has not yet been administered. The MAR can be accessed from the BPA hyperlink.



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## **MAR Updates**

Once ordered, the Influenza Vaccine will display as a scheduled medication.



## **Discharge Navigator**

If the influenza vaccine has been ordered but the patient has not received the vaccination, when the Nurse opens the Discharge Navigator, a BPA is triggered to alert the Nurse that the vaccine has not been administered.


 The BPA contains a hyperlink to the MAR; allowing documentation of the administration or patient refusal directly on the MAR.



## **After Visit Summary**

If the vaccination was ordered and not administered, a final reminder will display to alert the need to administer the vaccination or document the refusal on the MAR before printing the AVS.

• The Nurse can click the alert to go to the MAR to document the administration or patient refusal of the ordered Influenza Vaccine.



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
