Top Five Facts About Patient Information Transparency

MyNM changes begin on March 30 at Northwestern Medicine

- 1. Patients have the right under HIPAA to access their health data.
- 2. 21st Century Cures Act requires providers to remove barriers to electronic access.
- 3. Ambulatory setting: Signed physician/APP notes will be released to MyNM at the close of an encounter. Test results (labs and imaging) that are finalized prior to midnight will be released to MyNM at 9 am the next day.
 - Lab results released manually today (such as pathology) will be auto-released at 14 days.
 - Lab results blocked today (such as Huntington's) will remain blocked.
- **4. Hospital setting**: Signed physician/APP notes and finalized test results (labs and imaging) will be released to MyNM after discharge.
- 5. In limited circumstances, physicians may block a note, or block or delay a result from MyNM for one of the following reasons*:
 - Reasonable likelihood of causing harm to the patient or another individual
 - Patient requested not to receive the result or note in MyNM
 - * Patients may request to receive any note or result from HIM, including those that have been blocked
