Dr. Catalona is a professor of Urology, director of the Clinical Prostate Cancer Program for Robert H. Lurie Comprehensive Cancer Center at Northwestern University, and medical director of the Urological Research Foundation who is widely published and has won numerous awards.

He is an expert in performing the “nerve-sparing” radical prostatectomy that can preserve sexual potency. His globally recognized prostate cancer research focuses on at-risk populations, diagnosis, treatment outcomes, and the molecular biology of lethal prostate cancer. He was first to show that the PSA test could be used as a first-line screening for prostate cancer, and he helped develop the “free” PSA test. He has led national studies and established and directed the largest single-institution longitudinal prostate cancer-screening program in the United States.
