


Connecting to the NM Mobile Wireless Network

NOTE: VCS works over Wi-Fi or cellular whether you are on an NM campus or not. However, some public Wi-Fi networks (i.e.: Starbucks, hotels) require users to authenticate by accepting terms and conditions. If you do not perform this step, your device may not connect to VCS. You can resolve this by accepting the terms and conditions or disabling Wi-Fi.


Notification Settings/Behavior for Android Users

Notification Behavior when receiving messages:

If you are in the VCS App but not in the Secure Messages screen, a notification appears at the top of the screen.



On a locked screen with Hide sensitive content, user will only show that they have a VCS alert with no verbiage. If you're in another App & the VCS App is running in the background, the tone & vibration for the message's priority are played. Depending on your device and operating system, you may see notification text at screen top:



NOTE: On a locked screen, the tone/vibration for the message's priority are played.*
